



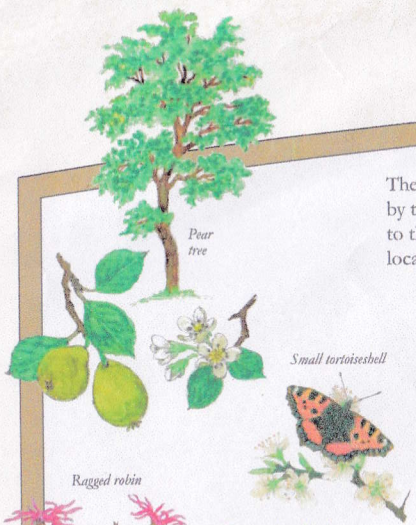

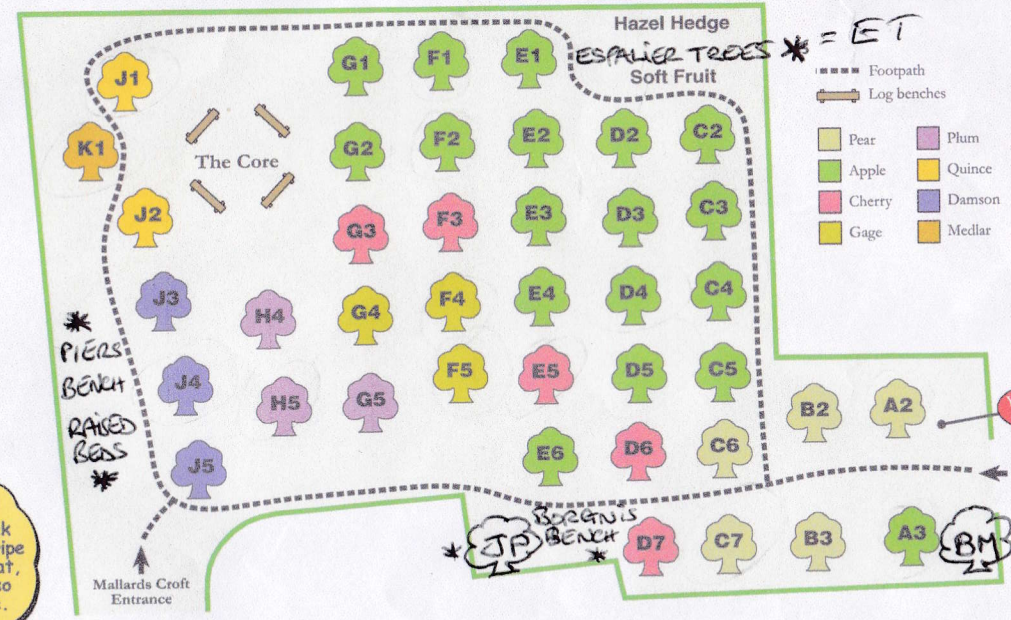
The Orchard sits on an old pasture meadow formally owned by the Farrah-Bell family. Ownership of the field transferred to the Parish Council in 2015 and following consultation with local residents it was decided to create this communal orchard.

Residents, school children and staff from local business came together to plant the trees and soft fruit bushes that are now a legacy for future generations.



The orchard is home to a wide range of wildflowers including ox-eye daisy, campion, common vetch, ragged robin, black medick, speedwell, cut-leaved cranesbill, greater knapweed, and several different meadow grass species.
