(STANBRIDGE ROAD, HADDENHAM)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER, 2020

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL have hereby given notice that, Thames Water works take place and it is anticipated that the works will commence on 20 March 2020 and will take approximately 3 days between 08:00 and 23:59 each day to complete.

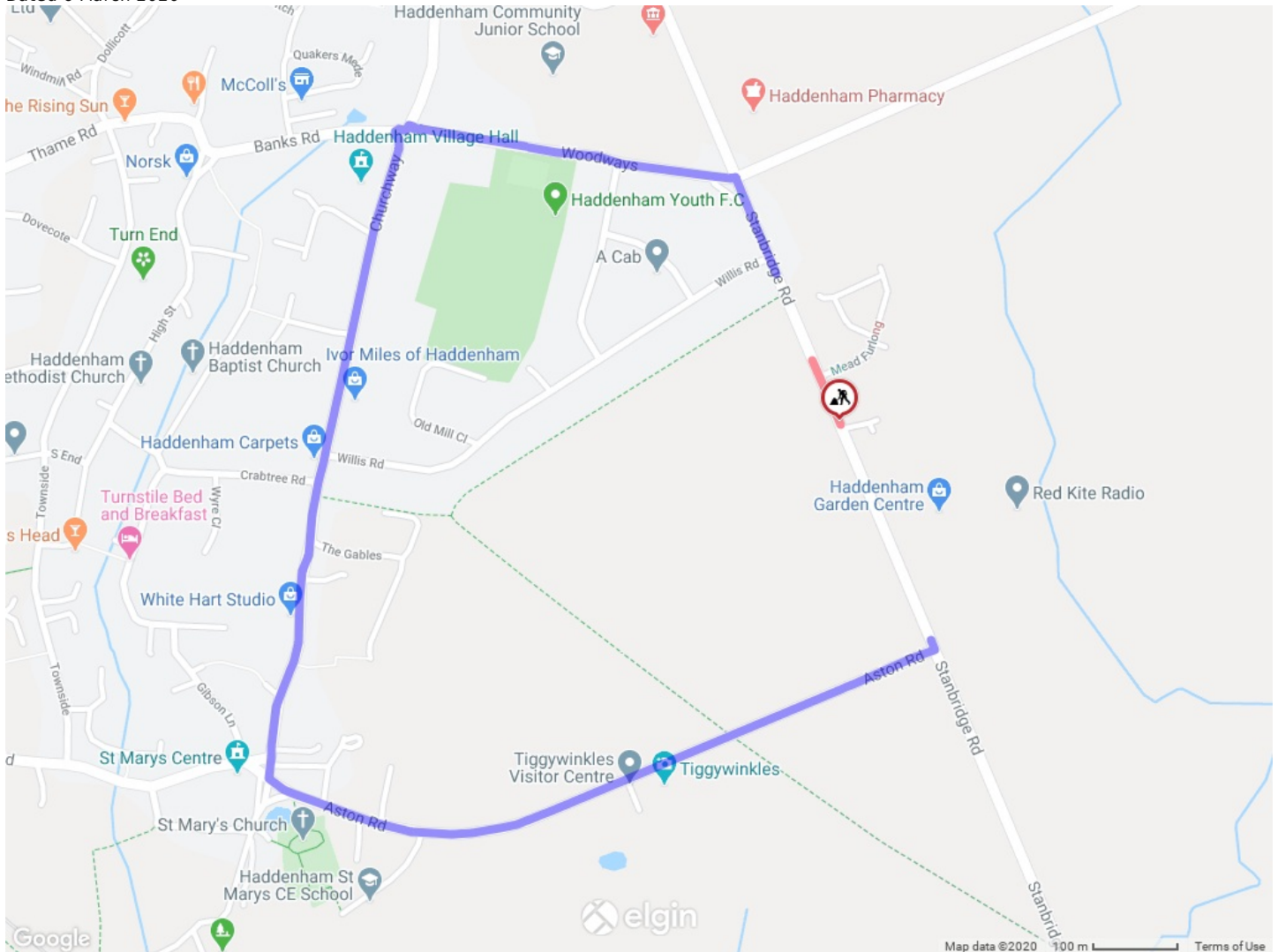
BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make an Order which will temporarily prohibit any vehicle from proceeding, except for access, in that length of Stanbridge Road, Haddenham, which continues for a distance of approximately 85 metres.

The alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be via Stanbridge Road, Aston Road, Church End, Churchway, Banks Road, Woodways and vice versa.

The Order will come into operation on 20 March 2020 when the appropriate signs are lawfully displayed and will continue for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the said works have been completed whichever is the earlier.

Penalties for not observing these restrictions will be as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
