

Local Area Bulletin – Haddenham and Long Crendon

May 2011

This bulletin gives you the latest news from Locality Services about community projects and initiatives in your local area, which you might like to include in your local newsletters.

- The recent project on environmental awareness amongst local schoolchildren resulted in an average energy saving of 11.4% but over a quarter of households reduced their usage by 25%. Full results to be announced later this year.
- The LAF agreed funding to assist the Haddenham Youth Café and £2050 was provided towards the cost of a new minibus. Working together with The Winslow & District LAF to provide funding, this facility will be of real benefit to the youth of the area.
- Further funding was provided to Haddenham **in Transition** to buy a thermal imaging camera to assist in surveys of properties to assist in reducing energy wastage and to work towards greater environmental sustainability in the area.
- Supported by the LAF, “Carers Bucks” held an event for people who care for sick, aged or infirm people in the area, attended by a wide number of agencies, charities and organizations, the day gave opportunities for carers to discover available support and assistance and to meet with carers in similar situations.
