



Local Council Consultancy Report February 2024

- Purpose: to review the PC's profile, responsibilities, assets, resources & staffing in the context of 50% growth by 1000 homes (2500 people), and likely future expansion
- Assessment: Haddenham PC today meets the evaluation criteria of a large parish council, indeed has many of the assets and functions of a small town, but is operating with the resource profile of a medium sized PC
